The CURRICULUM

Sir John Cass & Red Coat School offers a broad and balanced curriculum to all students.

The school's curriculum encourages a thirst for knowledge and understanding and a love of learning. We ensure that all are equipped for the next phase of their lives by giving students a range of subjects to study as well as opportunities to develop academic, technical and sporting excellence.

We believe passionately in the development of the whole child, acquiring the knowledge and skills needed not only for academic success, but for lifelong success.

Each Key Stage is defined by the Core Characteristics that we as a school will help to develop in each child:

- KS3 – Independent Learners
- KS4 – Subject Masters
- KS5 – Critical Scholars

We promote learning in the widest context and so all of our students understand British values and what it means to be a 21st century citizen in this vibrant capital of London. Alongside the academic curriculum, students' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development is nurtured throughout their journey at the school. This is also underpinned by our own core belief, "do unto others as you would have them do unto you" Luke 6:31.

In Key Stage 3, students study English, Mathematics, Science, Religious Education, History, Geography, a Modern Foreign Language, Art, Design Technology, Drama, Music, Computer Science, PSHE and Physical Education (this includes swimming lessons in our own on-site swimming pool).

At the end of Year 9 students receive bespoke careers education and next step guidance in preparation for choosing their option for Key Stage 4.

At Key Stage 4, there is a wide range of courses to study both at GCSE and BTEC level. This is also the case at Key Stage 5.

Our curriculum offer mirrors our highly ambitious intentions for each and every child who attends Sir John Cass & Red Coat School. This is reflected in our examinations results which are continually above the national average, with the vast majority of students going on to highly established further and higher education establishments.


At Sir John Cass & Red Coat we are committed to ensuring every student achieves their potential.
