INFORMATION

The Stepney All Saints School is a thriving, successful and innovative voluntary aided school, rich in linguistic and cultural heritage. It was identified by the Department for Education as one of the highest achieving and fastest improving schools in the country for 4 consecutive years, with outstanding GCSE results and highest 'A' Level scores. Ofsted rates our school as OUTSTANDING (Nov 2015).

As a Church school, we are proud and committed to our Christian distinctiveness. We aspire to be a welcoming, inclusive family with a strong Christian ethos, a sense of community and a commitment to excellence for all children in our care.

As well as Ofsted and its rigorous inspections, as a church school, we are subject to a second inspecting regime called SIAMS (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools). In our SIAMS inspection on 22nd and 23rd May 2018 Sir John Cass Red Coat was judged to be an OUTSTANDING church school.

Headline figures for the 2020 GCSE results at Sir John Cass Red Coat are as follows:

- The school has a Progress 8 score of +0.8. This is outstanding progress and means that on average students get +0.8 of a grade better at Stepney All Saints School compared to other schools nationally.

This means that our results are significantly above the national average and amongst the highest in the borough of Tower Hamlets.

Our 2020 Sixth Form results are as follows:
