## **Re: January 2022 Mock Examination timetable – Year 9**

The timetable for the Year 9 Mock examinations in January 2022 is on the reverse of this letter. Please note down the relevant dates and times and ensure that you are properly prepared for each examination. Topic checklists will be posted on Year 9 Google Classroom and your subjects will provide individual support.

These mocks are organised and run the same way that public examinations are so strict examination rules apply.

Under the unique circumstances that we find ourselves in, we kindly request that all students bring at least two black pens (one spare) for all examinations and any other necessary equipment, such as a calculator and pencil. Under no circumstances must you take a mobile phone or any digital devices with you in the examination room. Bottles of water (label must be removed) may be taken into the exam hall. Under new exam regulations, watches of any type are not permitted in the exam room.

For all examinations, the following procedures apply. For **AM exams go to your form room as normal**, your form tutor will bring you down to the examination room at 08:50. **For PM exams please go straight from lunch to your examination room at 13:50**. It is vital that you arrive for your examinations on time. All students are expected in lessons as normal when there is not an exam scheduled.

Exams will be held across the following rooms; *The Great Hall, The Cube, S04, and S05*. Upon your return in January the Exam team will post up rooming and seating arrangements on the Exam noticeboard and also in your form rooms so please keep an eye out for this.

As per last academic year, students with Access Arrangements, will sit all exams in allocated rooms and will be provided with the necessary provisions by SEN Department.

A polite reminder that facemasks are mandatory in communal areas. We ask that all students enter all exam rooms wearing a face mask. During your exams you have the option to remove your mask. Once the exam is over, we expect students to wear a face mask when leaving the Exam room.

I wish you the best of luck with all your examinations; I hope you will prepare thoroughly and make this a positive start to the new half-term.
