I am writing with reminders for events that are coming up in the next couple of weeks.

Student Induction Day (5.7.24)

The secondary induction day for Year 6 students takes place on Friday 5th July. In addition to meeting key staff and experiencing our school routine, students will hear about important rules and systems that operate in Stepney All Saints and will be given guidance on how to make the best start possible.

Students should arrive from 9am via the Bromley Street gate. From there they will be accompanied to our main hall where they will join their groups for the day. Lunch will be provided free of charge. Students may wear their own clothes.

The induction day will end at 1.30pm and we ask that parents collect their children from the Bromley Street gate. Please wait opposite the gate on the green rather than immediately outside the gate as this causes congestion.

Coffee Morning for parents (3.7.24)

On Wednesday 3rd July, two days before the student induction day, our coffee morning for parents/carers will run from 9.15am until 10.45am in which we will talk to you about the transition process and life at our school. You will have an opportunity to meet key staff and to ask questions. Please arrive from 9am via the Stepney Way gate.
